## SCHOOL BOARD ACTION

Authorize Dr. Mayes to reach out to the Exeter School District to request a study be done on the possibility of a merger with the Antietam School District.

Exonerate Fulton Bank from collecting 2011 real estate taxes from Lower Alsace Township and Mt. Penn Borough, and approve the Antietam School District's submittal of these taxes as delinquent to Berks County Tax Claim Bureau for collection.

Approve 2012-2013 preliminary general fund expenditure budget in the amount of \$15,268,143.

Approve the filing of a Request for Referendum Exception with the PA Department of Education for each exception for which the District qualifies.

Approve budget transfers for the 2011-2012 school year, as presented.

Approve the referral agreement between the Antietam School District and CONCERN, as presented.

Accept a Repository Bid in the amount of \$100 for parcel no. 64-5326-05-07-0956, located in the Borough of Mt. Penn.
