202. ELIGIBILITY OF NONRESIDENT STUDENTS	
<p>1. Purpose SC 501, 502</p>	<p>The Board shall operate the schools of this district for the benefit of children resident in this district and eligible for attendance.</p>
<p>2. Authority SC 1301, 1316</p> <p>SC1302 Title 22 Sec. 11.19</p> <p>SC 1302 Pol. 906</p>	<p>The Board may permit the admission of nonresident students in accordance with terms of this policy.</p> <p>The Board shall require that appropriate legal documentation showing dependency or guardianship or a sworn statement or residential support be filed with the Board Secretary before an eligible nonresident student may be accepted as a student in the district schools. The Board may require a resident to submit additional reasonable information to substantiate a sworn statement, in accordance with guidelines issued by the Department of Education.</p> <p>The Board reserves the right to verify claims of residency, dependency, and guardianship and to remove from school attendance a nonresident student whose claim is invalid.</p> <p>If information contained in the sworn statement of residential support is found to be false, the student shall be removed from school after notice is given of an opportunity to appeal the student's removal, in accordance with Board Policy 906, Public Complaints.</p> <p>The Board shall not be responsible for transportation to or from school for any student residing outside school district boundaries.</p>
<p>SC 1316, 2561</p> <p>3. Guidelines SC 1305</p>	<p>Tuition rates shall be determined in accordance with statute. Tuition shall be charged monthly, in advance of attendance.</p> <p><u>Nonresident Children Placed In The District</u></p> <p>Any child placed in the home of a resident of this district by a court or an agency of government shall be admitted to the schools and shall receive the same benefits and be subject to the same duties as resident children.</p>

<p>SC 1316</p>	<p><u>Future Residents</u></p> <p>A student eligible for attendance whose parent has executed a contract to buy, build, or rent a residence in this district for occupancy by September 30th may be enrolled without payment of tuition.</p> <p>If the student does not become a resident of the district by the end of the period for which free attendance is given, tuition shall be required until residency is established.</p> <p>Parents of students who claim admission on the basis of future residency shall be required to demonstrate proof of the anticipated residency.</p>
<p>SC 1316</p>	<p><u>Former Residents</u></p> <p>Regularly enrolled students whose parents have moved out of the school district may be permitted to finish the school year without payment of tuition when the parents move from the district during the last sixty (60) school days of the current school year.</p> <p>Regularly enrolled students with senior status whose parents have moved out of the school district may be permitted to finish the school year without payment of tuition when the parents move from the district during the student's senior year of school provided that the student has been continuously enrolled in the district for the past two (2) school years.</p>
<p>SC 1302 Title 22 Sec. 11.19</p>	<p><u>Other Nonresident Students</u></p> <p>A nonresident student may be admitted to this district without payment of tuition where attendance is justified on the grounds that the student lives full-time and not just for the school year with district residents who have assumed legal dependency or guardianship or residential support of the student. These students must be approved by the Board through the recommendations of the Superintendent.</p>
<p>4. Delegation of Responsibility</p>	<p>The Superintendent or designee shall develop procedures for the enrollment of nonresident children which:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Admit such students only on proper application and submission of required documentation by the parent or guardian. 2. Verify claims of residency.
