POSTGRADUATE STUDENTS</p> <p>The Board of School Directors will consider the extension of the privilege of postgraduate study graduates resident in this district upon proper application and the satisfaction of the following condition(s):</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The specific objective of the candidate is dependent upon the completion of certain courses offered at the high school.</li> <li>2. The past scholastic and behavioral conduct of the candidate are such as to predict success in the selected postgraduate courses.</li> <li>3. The needs of undergraduate students regularly enrolled in the school are met and classroom space and instructional staff are available.</li> </ol> <p>The Board may approve, on the recommendation of the Superintendent, each qualified application for postgraduate studies before the student may begin such studies. Such approval shall not be construed to extend beyond the academic year for which application is made.</p> <p>The continued attendance of each admitted postgraduate student shall be contingent upon the maintenance of a satisfactory academic performance, regular attendance, and a record of good conduct.</p> <p>The Board will not assume responsibility for the transportation of students pursuing postgraduate studies.</p>
