DRESS CODE

It is felt that a definitive dress code is not necessary because of the good taste that most of the student body has exhibited. The clothing of the students should not be disruptive, bring undue attention to the wearer, or cause unnecessary comments. The following are clarifications on disputed or controversial rules but are not intended to be all encompassing.

Shorts may be worn year round. The length of all shorts and skirts must be at or below the end of the wearer's fingertips when his/her arms are extended down by his/her sides.

Inappropriate clothing and accessories include those having messages or pictures with references to drugs, ethnic/racial harassment, tobacco, alcohol, suicide, blatant sexuality, or profanity.

Shirts and tops must cover undergarments, the waist and lower back completely. Judgment on low cut tops may be made by the administration. Cut off tops may not be worn.

Holes in pants must be below the fingertip length rule as described above and may not be larger than a fist.

Hats, bandannas, headbands, may not be worn in school without permission such as an approved spirit event.

Sports Spandex may not be worn unless shorts or a top extending to fingertip length are worn over top.

Undergarments may not be seen through or hanging out of clothing.

Clothing or accessories that are the source of disrupting noise may be judged inappropriate by an administrator.

No clothing or footwear, including cleats, that can cause damage to property may be worn.

Because of health reasons, shoes must be worn on

school property.

Coats, sunglasses, and chains may not be worn in school.
