SOCIAL EVENTS AND CLASS TRIPS</p> <p>1.Purpose The Board recognizes the value of student social events and class trips in enchancing and enriching the school experience for the children of this school district. In addition, the Board recognizes that some requests for trips are of a special and unusual educational nature that they cannot be completed within a normal, single school day and provide benefits quite unique to the students involved.</p> <p>2.Authority The Board will make school facilities available and provide appropriate staff for the conduct of social events within the school facilities which have been approved by the building principal.</p> <p>As voluntary participants in school social events and class trips, students shall be held responsible for compliance with rules set forth in advance for their conduct; and infractions of those rules will be subject to the same disciplinary measures as are applied during the regular school program. Participation in social events is not a right and may be denied to any student who has demonstrated disregard for the rules of the school.</p> <p>Overnight trips will be allowed in the following cases:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. In the areas of academics, athletics, and music where earned as a result of advancement through competition on district and state levels, expenses will be paid by the district. 2. Officers and members of school clubs will be able to take advantage of special opportunities such as state or national conventions. Registration, lodging, and travel expenses will be the responsibility of the organization. Clubs may require that individuals pay part or all costs. 3. Overnight group trips other than those noted above will be considered separately by the Board. Advisors are to follow the guidelines established by the administration for these specific cases.
