Students can select from three coursework options:


- ▶ Full time online coursework completed at home
- ▶ Full time coursework online with face-to-face support in the school environment if/as necessary
- ▶ Part time coursework online and part time coursework in the school environment with additional face-to-face support as necessary.
 - AVA students will be enrolled in their four core courses online (language arts, math, social studies and science)
 - AVA students may enroll in elective courses online or may enroll in elective courses offered in the school buildings
