Change to Instructional Model

No Simple Answers

- As we are all keenly aware, there are no neat and simple answers
- Whether we remain virtual or return in hybrid, there will be gains and losses
- > Want to ensure everyone is clear-eyed, especially parents who will choose an option for their students

Changes with the Hybrid Model

- Students in need of in-person support will have more direct support at least 2 days per week
- Should support some of the social-emotional needs that may not be so easily met virtually
- Virtual instruction will not look like it does right now
 - Staff will no longer have full attention dedicated to the virtual learning
 - They will be managing in-person and virtual simultaneously
- Returning now (and the need to establish classroom routines) means that instruction will definitely slow

Changes with the Hybrid Model

- All buildings will return to typical in-person daily schedule
 - For students remaining fully virtual, this will represent an increase in screen time
- Lessons will no longer be recorded
 - Students will need to stream in live if they are virtual
 - The only instruction available will be in real time
 - If they cannot, they should register for AVA
- Student and staff safety and health will require more restricted movement and impact personalized learning
