IMPORTANT INFO:

- The Program is **FREE** to all children 18 years of age and under.
- You do not need to qualify for the free or reduced meal program to receive free summer meals.
- You do not need to live in the district to receive free summer meals.
- Children should have the ability to chew food. Infant food is not available.
- Small children should be accompanied by an adult.
- Adults can also purchase a meal to enjoy with their child.
- No advance sign up is required to participate.
