

MPPC Arrival and Dismissal Procedures 2022-2023

At the Mount Penn Primary Center, there will be three options for arrival/dismissal:

- Students who will arrive by bus or daycare transportation
- Students who will walk with a parent from home.
 - You will not be allowed to drive up and park at the building. You must walk from your home, if your child is classified as a walker.
- Students who are car riders.
 - Parents will remain in their cars and we will utilize the U-Shaped driveway in front of the building.

Arrival Procedures

Any Students Eating Breakfast	Any student eating breakfast should enter the doors on Endlich Ave at 8:00 AM.
Bus/Day Care Vans	Buses and vans will arrive at the doors on Endlich Ave. and students will remain in the gym until dismissed to the classrooms at 8:20.
Walkers	If you plan to walk with your student to the building, students will enter the building at 8:20 through the upper door on Filbert Ave. Parents will not be permitted to drive and park near the school and walk up the door. This is only for students who will be walking from home with their parents.
Car Riders	We will be utilizing the U-Shaped driveway in front of the building. Parents must remain in their cars while waiting and dropping off students. The line will form on Filbert Ave. Please enter the line/U-Shaped driveway from Filbert. If you arrive at the intersection of Filbert and 25th, please go around the block and join the back of the line. We will begin letting children in the building at 8:20 . ** It will be helpful if the child is seated behind the passenger seat so they can easily exit the car from the right side. Helping your child learn how to buckle and unbuckle on their own, will also keep the line moving.

Dismissal Procedures

Bus/Day Care Vans	Busses and vans will dismiss at the doors on Endlich Ave.
Walkers	Students that are walking home with a parent will leave the building through the upper door on Filbert Ave. Parents will not be permitted to drive and park near the school and walk up the door. This is only for students who will be walking from home with their parents. ** Each family will be assigned a number. Students will receive backpack tags and tags to be given to the person/sibling/family member responsible for walking them home on the first day of school. The student will have the number on their back pack tag. Students will only be dismissed to individuals who have the corresponding number tag to the student's backpack tag.
Car Riders	We will be utilizing the U-Shaped driveway in front of the building. Parents must remain in their cars while waiting to pick up students. The line will form on Filbert Ave. Please enter the line/U-Shaped driveway from Filbert. If you arrive at the intersection of Filbert and 25th, please go around the block and join the back of the line. ** Each family will be assigned a number. Students will receive numbered backpack tags on the first day of school, and will also be given a corresponding number tag to be given to the parent, or whoever is responsible for picking up the student. The tag must be hung from the rearview mirror of the car and be clearly displayed each day when picking up the student.

MPEC Arrival and Dismissal Procedures 2022-2023

At the Mount Penn Elementary Center, there will be three options for arrival/dismissal:

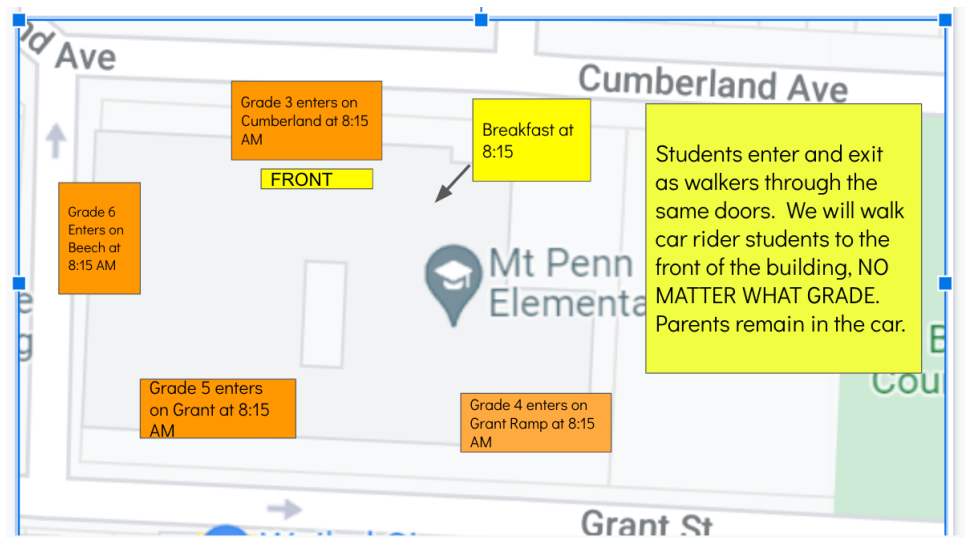
- Students who will arrive by bus or daycare transportation
- Students who will walk with a parent from home
 - You must walk from your home, if your child is classified as a walker.
- Students who are car riders
 - Parents will remain in their cars and line up in front of the building on Cumberland Ave

Arrival Procedures

Breakfast	Any student eating breakfast will enter through the cafeteria doors on Cumberland at 8:15 AM.
Bus/Vans	Buses and vans will arrive at the doors on Cumberland by the cafeteria and students will remain in the cafeteria until dismissed to the classrooms at 8:15 AM.
Walkers	If you plan to walk with your student to the building, students will enter the building at 8:15 through the appropriate grade level door: 3rd Grade - Cumberland Entrance (Main door) 5th Grade - Grant Street Door 4th Grade - Grant Street Gym Ramp Door 6th Grade - Beech Street Door At 8:30 AM Grade level doors will be closed and all students must enter through the main entrance
Car Riders	Car riders should begin lining up in the front of the building (Cumberland) as far down as the orange cones/Student Drop Off Sign. Parents must remain in their cars while waiting and dropping off students. We will begin letting children in the building at 8:15 AM . If you are dropping off in the back side at Grant, please do not drop your child prior to 8:15 AM. Students are not supervised until 8:15 AM. Parents must remain until 8:15.

Dismissal Procedures

Bus/Vans	Busses and vans will dismiss at the doors on Cumberland.
Walkers	Students that are walking home will leave the building through the same doors they enter in the AM at 3:00 PM . Walkers will be cleared from the perimeter of building prior to the dismissal of car riders.
Car Riders	Afternoon car riders should begin lining up along Cumberland no earlier than 2:45 PM. Parents must remain in their cars while waiting to pick up students. Please pull all the way down to the orange cones/Pick Up Sign when waiting/picking up. Double parking is not permitted.



MSHS Arrival and Dismissal Procedures 2022-2023

At the Middle-Senior High School, there will be four options for arrival/dismissal:

- Students who will utilize the BARTA bus
- Students who will walk
- Students who are car riders (driven by parent/guardian and dropped off/picked up)
- Students who drive themselves and park in the school parking lot

Arrival/Dismissal Procedures

Doors Open at 7:45 AM, Students are dismissed at 2:45 PM

BARTA Bus	Students exit/board the BARTA bus at the designated stop, and then walk to the building.
Walkers	Students walk to and from school, and enter the building at the designated entrances.
Car Riders	<p>Arrival: Drivers will need to pull as far forward as possible, to the “flag pole” entrance for grades 7 and 8, or to the “gym” entrance for grades 9-12. All students must be dropped off immediately, and drivers MUST exit the drive-through area as soon as their student is dropped off.</p> <p>*** THERE WILL BE NO STOPPING OR STANDING IN THE DRIVEWAY DURING ARRIVAL!***</p> <p>Dismissal: Drivers will pull as far forward as possible, all the way to the “gym” entrance to and wait for their student. All drivers must exit the drive-through area immediately after collecting their student.</p>
Student Drivers	Student drivers must register their car with the school, obtain a parking pass, and park in the school parking lot.
