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The Antietam School District has developed the following goals in the pursuit of increased academic achievement in the content assessed by annually-delivered PSSA and Keystone Exams.

Goal #1: The Antietam School District will increase the percentage of students who score proficient in mathematics as measured by the 2018 Math PSSA and/or Keystone Algebra I by 15% across all tested grade levels and students

Goal #2: The Antietam School District will increase the percentage of students who score proficient in ELA as measured by the 2018 ELA PSSA and/or Keystone Literature by 15% across all tested grade levels and students.

Goal #3: The Antietam School District will increase the percentage of students who score proficient in Science as measured by the 2018 Science PSSA and/or Keystone Biology by 15% across all tested grade levels and students.

To achieve these goals, the district has outlined four Action Steps that are commonly applied to each goal:

- Action Step: Ongoing development of district curriculum that is aligned to PA Common Core Standards (PA Standards for Science)
- Action Step: Alignment of instruction in ELA, Mathematics and Science to grade-level standards and eligible content
- Action Step: Use of data by professional staff to meaningfully differentiate instruction and engage students with benchmark data and progress toward student goals
- Action Step: Development of building and classroom culture that promotes learning and student achievement

Finally, the administrative team comprised of Directors and Principals, have developed specific and measurable Strategies to support the execution of the Action Steps and achievement of the District Goals.
